Function	function:Interferes with CBL-mediated down-regulation and degradation of receptor-type tyrosine kinases. Promotes accumulation of activated target receptors, such as T-cell receptors and EGFR, on the cell surface.,similarity:Contains 1 SH3 domain.,similarity:Contains 1 UBA domain.,subunit:Interacts with CBL. Part of a complex containing CBL and activated EGFR. Interacts with ubiquitin and with mono-ubiquitinated proteins.,
Background	This gene encodes a protein that contains a ubiquitin associated domain at the N-terminus, an SH3 domain, and a C-terminal domain with similarities to the catalytic motif of phosphoglycerate mutase. The encoded protein was found to inhibit endocytosis of epidermal growth factor receptor (EGFR) and
